O Visit Long Island, New York, where the novel is set, and explore the real-life locations that inspired the story.

02.

O Visit the Great Neck area of Long Island, which served as a source of inspiration for Fitzgerald's portrayal of West Egg.

03.

O Visit the Plaza Hotel in New York City, where parts of the novel are set, and experience its luxurious atmosphere.

04.

O Visit the Beacon Towers, a mansion that was once owned by the publisher of the novel and served as an inspiration for Gatsby's residence.

05.

O Take a boat ride along the Long Island Sound, similar to the boating scenes in the novel. You can join an organized The Great Gatsby Boat Tour.
